## Etiologies of Epilepsy in dogs and cats older than 6 years

### Infarct:

- Blocked pipe

### Bleeding:

- Pool filled with blood

### Hyperviscosity

- Man wading through the viscous blood

### Hypocalcemia + Hypocalcemia:

- Normally the testbox is filled with a sample of the poolwater to test the pH value and the amount of chloride
- In the picture the blood is tested for potassium and calcium, both levels are too low

### Uremia/ Hepatoencephalopathy

- The Ammonium which is dropping out off the bottle and is contaminating the water is illustrating the urinary excreted substances which are circulating in the blood vessels

### Primary and sekundary Neoplasias:

- The cauliflower floating in the pool is illustrating the primary tumor
- The cauliflowers in the basket are illustrating the metastasis
- The cauliflowers in general represent tumors, because of the cauliflower-like proliferation of some tumors
